After careful planning at all levels, classes have begun at Wagmatcookewey School. To keep everyone safe, we have changed a few things and added a few tasks as listed below:

Students need to wear their masks at all times if a 6 foot distance is not possible. Teachers will role model what a 6 foot distance looks like in person, so kids will get used to the space needed when another person is around.

Students must wear a mask before getting on the school bus. Masks stay on when they exit the bus and enter the school.

Each day there will be a station set up upon entering the school where a staff member will be checking temperatures and recording the numbers for tracking purposes.

Breakfast and lunch will be delivered to the classrooms.

The front doors will be locked as soon as the students are inside. **Do Not Send** your child to school before 8:30 a.m., as all staff are required to use this time to check their temperatures before students arrive.

Visitors and parents will not be permitted in the classrooms, but if you need to speak to any of the staff, call ahead and they will meet you at the door or in an office that has been designated as a meeting room.

The playground is closed.

Sports night has been cancelled until further notice.

As part of our safety plan, elementary students will attend on different days from the junior high and high school students. This will help limit the numbers of bodies in the building.


